



China Mobile unveils its Java 3.0 specification and CETK for Content Providers and Handset manufacturers

TOKYO, JAPAN - September 29, 2005 –

iaSolution Inc. announced today that China Mobile Communication Corporation (CMCC) has unveiled in its MTTF (Mobile Terminal Technology Forum) meeting on September 28, 2005 the new Java v3.0 specification and the associated CMCC extension toolkit (CETK) for content providers and handset manufacturers. CMCC Java v3.0 is developed based on international standard, with additional functions tailored to the local market. The specification is segmented into high, mid and low tiers targeting different market requirements.

Since March of 2005 when CMCC selected iaSolution as the exclusive supplier to provide a CETK to ensure all Java™ applications running on its terminals are compatible with CMCC extensions defined under its Java Terminal specifications for the next 2 years, iaSolution has supported CMCC to come up with its Java v3.0 specification and developed an upgraded version of CETK to fulfil such requirements. The Toolkit is able to support multi-languages, different screen size, interruption of incoming mobile phone events, PIM and most importantly, it is very easy to use.

“iaSolution will continue to bring our best unique set of capabilities to support CMCC in its Java strategy pursue. Currently, we have been working with several local manufacturers to deploy our Java solution based on CMCC Java 3.0 specification and those phones will be shipped to the market soon”. said Wesley Kuo, President and CSO of Aplix Corporation.

iaSolution has been a recognized leader of Java in the region since it was founded in 2000. The integration with Aplix was finalized in August 2004. The merged company's JBlend™ platform has shipped in more than 129 million mobile phones and consumer electronics devices, and has been licensed by 30 companies on over 200 phone models as of December 2004.
