Aplix, Acrodea Tie Up to Promote OpenKODE™

TOKYO, JAPAN – February 14, 2007 —Aplix Corporation (TSE:3727) and Acrodea Inc. (TSE:3823) announced today they have agreed to form a cooperative alliance to promote the broader use of OpenKODE™.

OpenKODE™ is a royalty-free, cross-platform standard that combines a set of native APIs into a comprehensive media stack specification for accelerating rich media and graphics applications. OpenKODE™ aims to make advanced media capabilities consistently available across multiple devices for increased native source portability and reduced mobile platform fragmentation. Both Aplix and Acrodea have participated in the membership of developing OpenKODE™ in the Khronos Group. Acrodea plays one of the major roles as a key participant in the developing OpenKODE™, and Aplix contributes to define specifications.

Aplix will utilize Acrodea's OpenKODE™ solutions in their JBlend and AMF (Aplix Middleware Framework). Acrodea will use Aplix's Java-based solutions and platform solutions in their pilot targets. The two companies aim to achieve an organic union and effective utilization of the solutions they each have to offer, to promote broader use of OpenKODE™.

"Acrodea possesses state-of-the-art technology for engineering of mobile phone user interfaces", said Masaaki Sekino, President and Representative Director of Aplix. "We constantly have worked with Acrodea since its establishment. I am very happy about this latest arrangement, which will give us an opportunity to further deepen our cooperative relationship."

Acrodea CEO Junya Tsutsumi said, "I am happy to have this chance to work with Aplix, which has a high profile in Java platforms. By working together, I am confident we can make further



progress in promoting the broader use of OpenKODE™.”
